

Newmont Mining - SCM Process Equipment Category Manager

Description

Founded in 1921 and publicly traded since 1925, Newmont (www.newmont.com) is one of the largest gold companies in the world. Headquartered in Denver, Colorado, the company has approximately 34,000 employees and contractors, with the majority working at Newmont's core operations in the United States, Australia, Peru, Indonesia and Ghana. Newmont is the only gold company listed in the S&P 500 index and in 2007 became the first gold company selected to be part of the Dow Jones Sustainability World Index. Newmont's industry leading performance is reflected through high standards in environmental management, health and safety for its employees and creating value and opportunity for host communities and shareholders.

The SCM Process Equipment Category Manager prepares, administers, organizes and develops supply chain category strategy programs for primary and secondary categories globally. This role supports and assists the subject matter expert in the stage gate process and integration with key stakeholders. Assists in development of commercial and contracts integration with key suppliers and key stakeholders globally (projects, operations, and maintenance) as well as deliverables for the stage gate (stages 1-5) and operational readiness. Provides guidance to and develops business analysts.

Business Segments addressed through Category Management include Operations Equipment and Process Equipment.

Essential Duties include:

Develops, manages, and executes the Operations Equipment and Process Equipment sourcing and supplier relationships:

- Ultimately responsible for assisting in the identification of cost savings and process/service improvements opportunities annually.
- Assists in the development and implementation of the sourcing and purchasing strategy for process equipment (including all primary and secondary categories) globally for projects, operations, and maintenance.
- Coordinates with the technical services, project and business services, projects teams in each region and with suppliers to evaluate process equipment commercially and technically for all projects globally.
- Provides process equipment technical assistance to the projects and sites related to operational issues through SRM.
- Establishes relationships with internal and external customers as subject matter expert related to all process equipment issues.
- Assists in development of technical documents (Total Cost of Ownership) TCO models, should cost models, and price discipline models for the process equipment (primary and secondary categories) as required.
- Organizes, gathers, researches and analyzes relevant commodities, services and product information necessary to assist in the global, regional and local supply chain solutions.

The above duties and responsibilities are representative of the nature and level of work assigned and are not necessarily all-inclusive.

Qualifications

- Bachelor's Degree in Engineering, Business, Accounting or related field and/or a minimum of 8 years direct experience in the mining industry; including mine operations, mine maintenance, mine planning, mining equipment supply, or an equivalent combination of training and experience. A combination of domestic (US) and international experience is preferred.
- Significant knowledge of the mining equipment supplier industry.
- Strong computer literacy (Excel, Word, Power Point, Visio) and Microsoft XP is required.
- Purchase/Contract negotiation and development skills strongly preferred.

- CPM (Certified Purchasing Manager) is preferred.
- Travel to domestic and international locations and sites as required.
